
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Monthly Meetings

January: Whole Building Air Barrier Testing, Darek Brandt, P.E. Chief Engineer, Intertek PSI

provided This presentation background information regarding the evolution of the whole building air leakage rate testing and its' importance to a high performance, safe and habitable building. The presentation also described: the steps to be taken during testing; reasons for testing; test videos; myths and inaccurate perceptions regarding test requirements; test procedures; and how to interpret and understand the test results. Case studies and lessons learned wrapped up the discussion.

Message from Florida PTAC

The General Services Administration (GSA) reports that it is investigating the possibility of fraudulent activity within SAM, details of which you can find at:

https://www.gsa.gov/aboutus/organization/federal-acquisitionservice/office-of-systemsmanagement/integrated-award-environmentiae/sam-update.

This alleged activity could involve vendors' financial information. If a vendor's bank routing information in SAM has been exposed, it is possible for contract payments to be diverted to an unauthorized third party.
