





OASIS+ Unique Features

Streamlined IDIQ Ordering Environment thru 6 contract programs

Flexible Domain-based structure Industrial base of highly qualified contractors

Global access to commercial & non-commercial services

No evaluation of price at the contract level (use of 876 Authority)

No contract ceiling & no cap on number of awards

10-year consecutive coterminous ordering period

Open onramping after initial awards Technology based ordering & market research tools


Why These Acquisition Strategies

Industry Feedback Led to Concepts on:

Vetted Open Enrollment	I couldn't get in, and now I'm losing business I didn't meet the standards then, but I do now The standards are too high for small business
Combine Small and Large	If I size out of small, I don't qualify for large I'd have to onboard to both contracts I have to manage too many contracts
System Capabilities	No more email solicitations, please Turbo Tax it I have no visibility into customer behavior
Criteria Based Model	Scoring method isn't good for all small bus. Certifications should be a nice to have This model will help alleviate teaming needs
Comprehensive Data	Customers ask for the same thing in RFIs I want to showcase my capabilities I gave this to GSA, why can't customers see it

GSA Begins Initial OASIS+ RFP Evaluations

GSA's Office of Professional Services and Human Capital Categories (PSHC) and the OASIS+ team wish you a happy new year! The past year marked important milestones for the program including issuance and closing of the initial OASIS+ proposal submission period for all six Request for Proposals (RFPs) and the beginning of the proposal evaluation period.

We are moving full steam ahead and are currently focused on: evaluating proposals, developing an OASIS+ Ordering Guide, creating training that will equip customer agencies to start using the contract, and building a new OASIS+ website.

As we build our new website, we are looking for individuals, industry and customer agency representatives, to participate in website usability testing. If you are interested, and are either a vendor who has submitted a proposal or are with a customer agency who will use OASIS+, please send us an email with the following:

- o Profile: tell us if you are a supplier (who has submitted a proposal), or an agency customer (who will use the contract)

As a reminder, technical evaluations and awards will focus first on OASIS+ Total Small Business, followed by socioeconomic contract families and finally OASIS+ Unrestricted. The awards will be on a rolling basis throughout Q3 and Q4 FY 2024. Ordering period will overlap between the legacy OASIS and OASIS+ programs to ensure acquisition planning cycle times for our customer agencies remain seamless.

As we complete technical evaluations, our contracting team may reach out to offerors for clarifications on their proposals and supporting documentation. Clarifications are a standard practice as outlined in FAR15.306(a) Z. Please note that a clarification request does not mean that an offeror's proposal will be denied or accepted.

Finally, on January 11, we held our first customer focused OASIS+ overview training. You can now access the <u>recording</u> on our PSHC YouTube playlist and download the <u>presentation</u> for review. We will be scheduling additional training in the coming months.

Thank you for your continued support and commitment in helping us meet the demand for complex, non-IT, services solutions through the OASIS+ best-in-class (BIC), multi-agency contract (MAC) program. We'll continue to share details about our progress as the information becomes available.

OASIS+ Offer Submission System

- Symphony is the web-based tool for proposal management, preparation, and evaluation
- Allows for submission of multiple OASIS+ offers with the same, or as needed, different proposal information
- The tool helps to ensure your firm is proposing to the desired OASIS+ programs
- Access to the tool is available now for <u>registration</u>



Why did we consolidate the Multiple Award Schedule?

- Reduces contract duplication and increases competition in the Federal marketplace –
 - contractors will be able to offer all products and services on a single Schedule
- One set of terms and conditions across the MAS Program
 - ensuring more consistency in contracting practices
- Buyers will be better able to acquire total solutions under the new MAS NAICS-based SIN structure
